While the specific area of expertise is open, we are seeking a scholar whose work complements that of current Hampshire College faculty. We are particularly interested in ethnomusicologists who specialize in popular music (apart from jazz and improvisation studies), musics of the Middle East, India, Asia, and other regions. Our unique music program offers students the opportunity to study, compose, and perform jazz/improvised music, traditional and contemporary popular musics, folk and world musics, computer music/audio art, and experimental music in an interdisciplinary liberal arts context. Preference will be given to candidates who have experience in leading a music ensemble.

The successful candidate will have completed the PhD. College level teaching experience is preferred. This position involves substantial student advising responsibilities.
